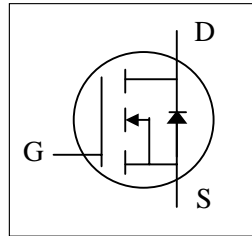




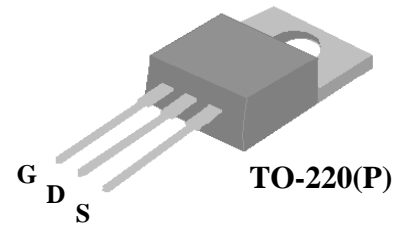

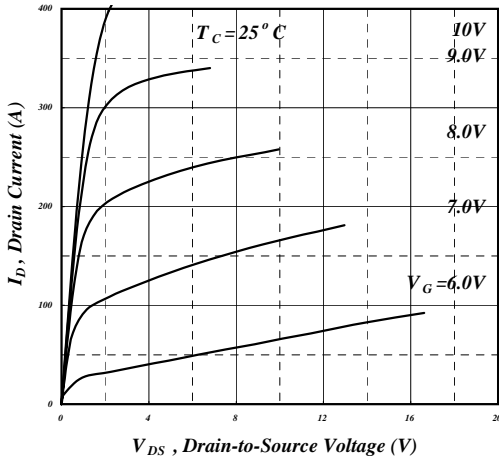


Fig 1. Typical Output Characteristics

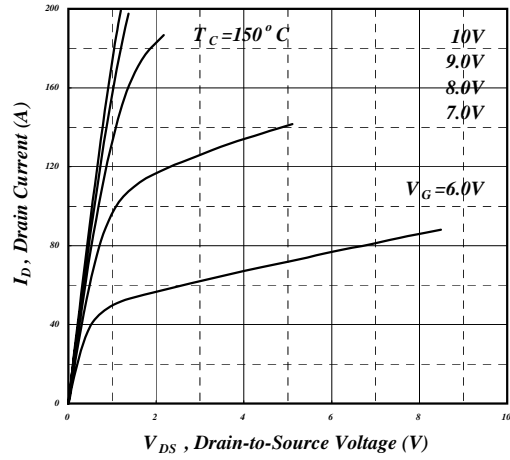


Fig 2. Typical Output Characteristics

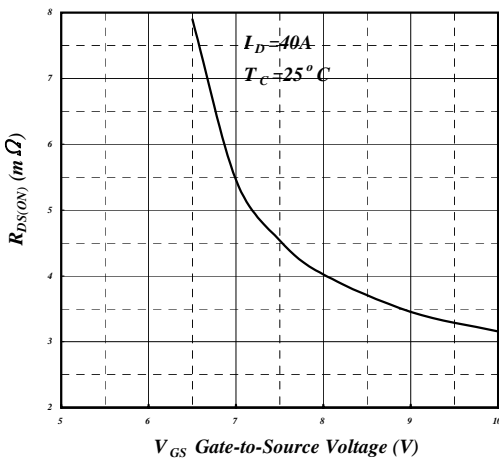


Fig 3. On-Resistance v.s. Gate Voltage

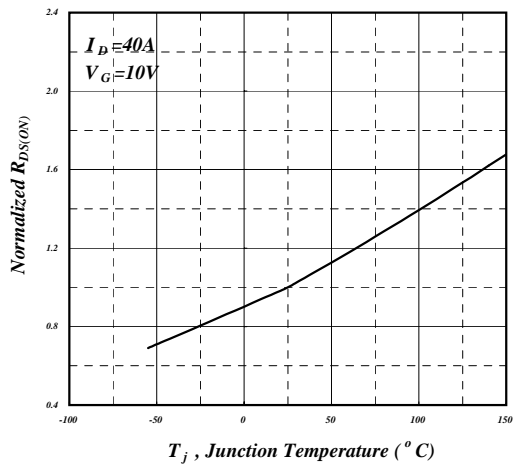


Fig 4. Normalized On-Resistance v.s. Junction Temperature

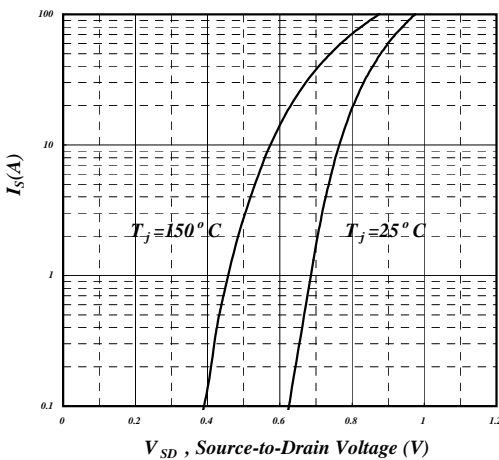


Fig 5. Forward Characteristic of Reverse Diode

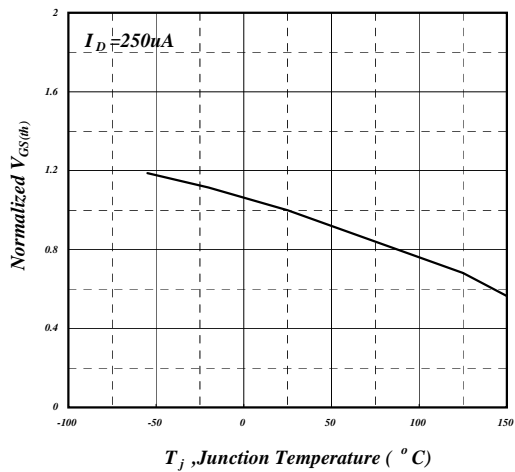


Fig 6. Gate Threshold Voltage v.s. Junction Temperature

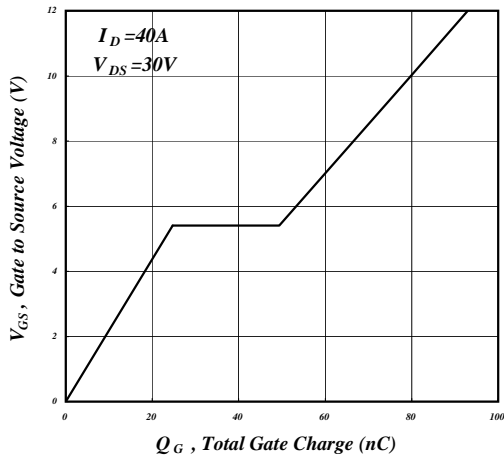


Fig 7. Gate Charge Characteristics

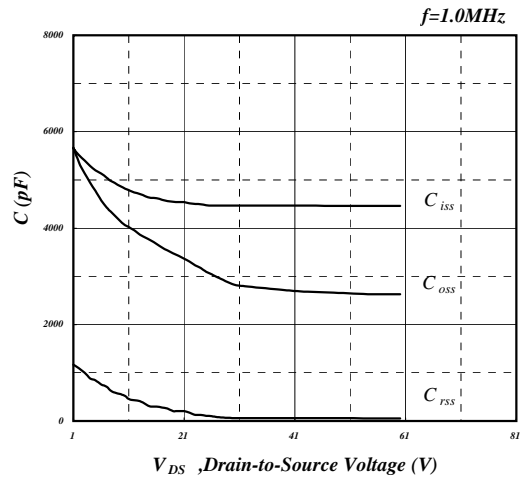


Fig 8. Typical Capacitance Characteristics

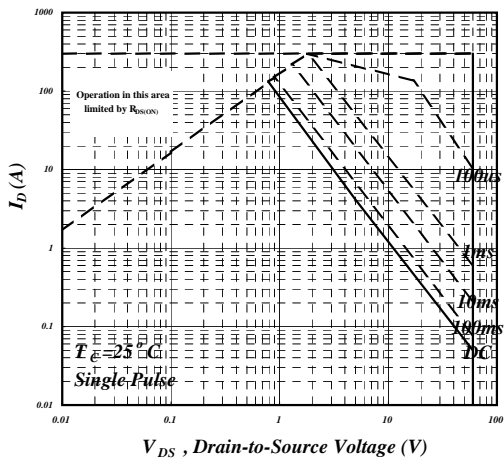


Fig 9. Maximum Safe Operating Area

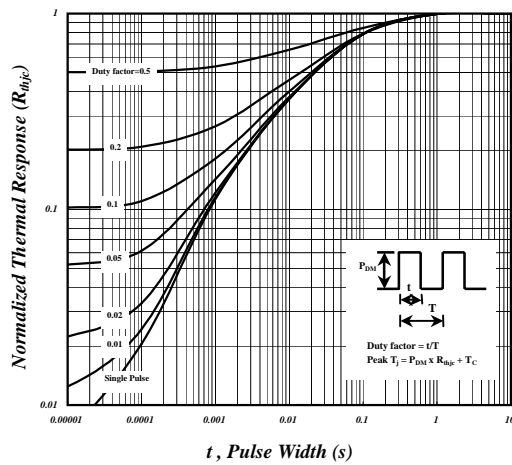


Fig 10. Effective Transient Thermal Impedance

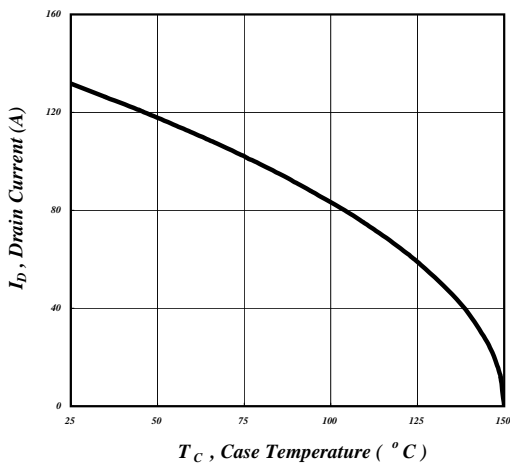


Fig 11. Drain Current v.s. Case Temperature

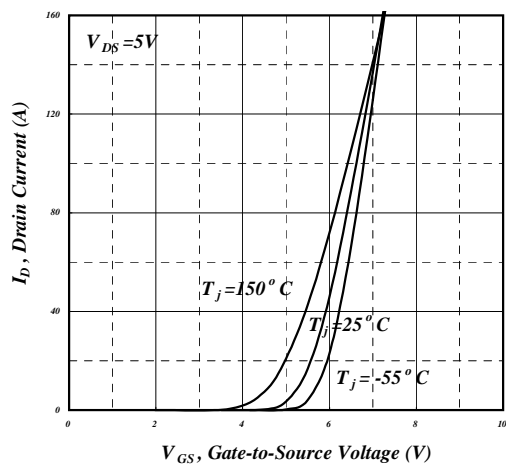


Fig 12. Transfer Characteristics

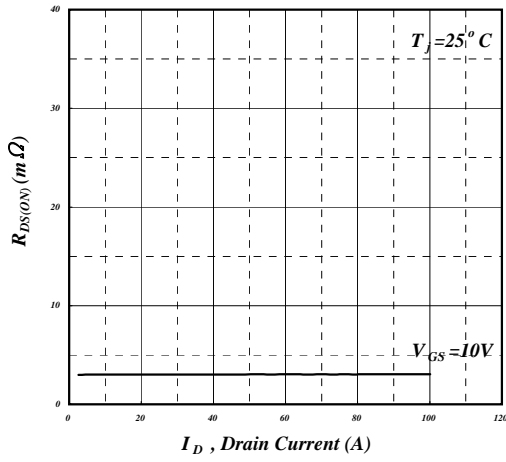


Fig 13. Typ. Drain-Source on State Resistance

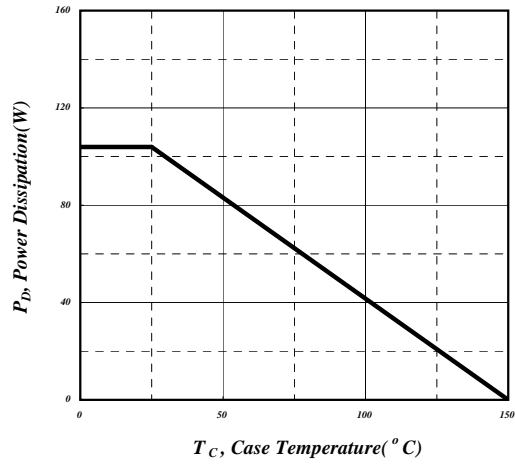


Fig 14. Total Power Dissipation

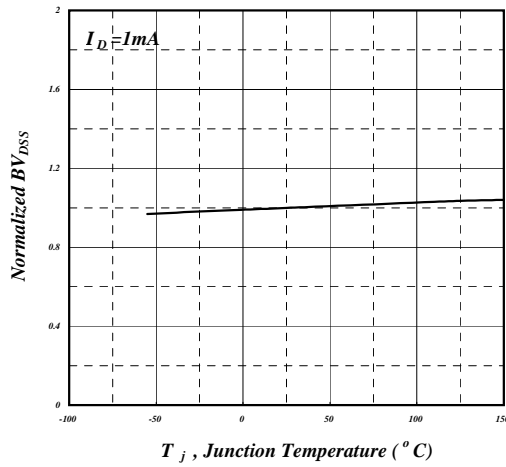


Fig 15. Normalized  $BV_{DSS}$  v.s. Junction Temperature
